#### **IGCSE Grade 10 Program**

At Phoenix Hybrid Academy, students in Grades 10 also known as IGCSE are required to choose a minimum of 5 subjects, all of which are completed online through ISWB.

### 5. School fees

Please note that the school does not offer discounts on tuition fees. This includes sibling discounts and employee discounts. Each child's fees are charged separately and are payable in full according to the school's fee structure.

#### **GRADE 1-3:**

Monthly payment of N\$ 3 000. Payable on the 1st day of each month from January to December (12 Months).

Once off registration and book fee of N\$ 3 000 before attending school. These are workbooks they will need to complete in class. Stationary is included and no need for parents to buy starting stationary, however lost or broken stationery is for the account of the parent or guardian. Stationary for homework is needed and for the account of the parent/guardian.

#### **GRADE 4-6:**

Monthly payment of N\$ 3 100. Payable on the 1st day of each month from January to December (12 Months).

Once off registration and book fee of N\$ 3 000 before attending school. This is for workbooks they will need to complete in class. Stationary is not included but all writing books and note books are included. Only desktop stationery is required and should be checked regularly by parents.

- Black, blue and green pens. NO erasable pens are allowed.
- Ruler and grey pencils. Calculators are not required for these stages.
- Scissors, glue and erasers NO TIPEX are allowed.
- At least 12 different coloring pencils.

**GRADE 7-9:** 

Monthly payment of N\$ 3 600. Payable on the 1st day of each month from January to

December (12 Months).

Once off registration and book fee of N\$ 3 000 before attending school. This is for

workbooks they will need to complete in class. Stationary is not included but all writing

books and note books are included. Only desktop stationery is required and should be

checked regularly by parents.

Black, blue and green pens. NO erasable pens are allowed

• Ruler and grey pencils.

Casio Fx-82 ZA Plus (scientific) Calculator, scissors, glue and erasers NO

TIPEX is allowed.

• At least 12 different coloring pencils.

IGCSE/ AS and A Level

Monthly payment of N\$ 2 600 per month for supervision.

Payable on the 1st day of each month from February to November (10 Months). Once

off registration fee of N\$ 3 000 this is including the registration fee for ISWB. Additional

cost per subject payable to phoenix that gets paid to ISWB estimated at N\$ 700 per

subject per month for IGCSE.

Please take note, at the end of the year IGCSE 2 learners write an external

examination from Cambridge University that has costs for each subject estimated

starting at N\$3500 per subject.

Additional support will be given when they need it, with the educators at Phoenix

Hybrid Academy. IGCSE and AS level, please choose 5 minimum subjects.

A level is not compulsory; it is an extra year for learning.

## 6. School Terms and holidays for 2026:

Term 1: School opens 13<sup>th</sup> January 2026 Closes 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026

Term 2: School opens 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026 Closes 21<sup>st</sup> August 2026

Term 3: School opens 7<sup>th</sup> September 2026 Closes 4<sup>th</sup> December 2026

## **School times:**

Grade 1&2 starts at 08:00 and end at 12:00.

Grade 3 starts at 08:00 and end at 12:30

Grade 4-9 starts at 08:00 and school ends at 13:00.

IGCSE, AS and A level starts at 08:00 and lessons end at 13:00, or when they are done with their lessons for the day.

## 7. Dress code:

 A school shirt is required at all sporting games and school trips. Also, every Wednesday for N\$300 per shirt.

#### • Girls:

- There is no official school uniform, but girls are expected to dress appropriately.
- Crop tops and short jeans are not permitted.
- Hair may be styled as desired, but it should not be so long that it obstructs their eyes.
- Please ensure that your daughters have the necessary sanitation products with them at all times.

#### Boys:

- There is no official school uniform, but boys are expected to dress appropriately.
- Hair may be styled as desired, but it should not be so long that it obstructs their eyes.
- Beanies: Beanies are allowed, but they must be worn in a way that allows educators to see the students' eyes.
- Hoodies: Hoodies are permitted, but students will be asked to remove them during class.

### 8: SCHOOL RULES:

- No Bullying: Bullying will not be tolerated; students engaging in such behavior will be asked to leave the school. Physical abuse towards any peer will have a two-week suspension and a disciplinary hearing will be held, to determine further suspension. Verbal abuse is a 10-point debit mark.
- **No Smoking:** Smoking is strictly prohibited on school grounds.
- No Vaping: Vaping is not allowed on school grounds.
- **Appropriate Language:** No swearing or use of inappropriate language.
- **Respect:** Be respectful towards all peers and teachers.
- No Vandalism: Vandalizing school property or the property of others is forbidden.
- Permission Required: Students may not leave school property without permission from their register teacher.
- **Phone Use:** Phones are not to be used during class time.
- No Gaming/Video Streaming: Gaming, watching videos, or using YouTube during class time is not allowed.
- There is also a school debit and credit mark system on which learners' behavior and discipline is monitored on.

#### **Debit mark system:**

**10-points**: verbal warning

**20-points**: parent notification

**30-points**: detention or counselling

**50-points**: two-week suspension, with a disciplinary hearing for further

suspension.
